CALL TO ORDER

Student Trustee R. Barnes called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

REVIEW OF AGENDA

Student Trustee H. Jamal reviewed the agenda and Student Trustee R. Barnes collected Student Senator Roles and Responsibilities Forms at 7:02 p.m.

CONTINUED DISCUSSION ON FEES FOR LEARNING MATERIALS

Student Trustee H. Jamal collected additional feedback and incidents of fees for learning materials in schools (re: October meeting; Board Policy 6011, Administrative Procedure 4900) at 7:05 p.m.

- Students required to purchase French cahier for \$30 and read-only copies/no-fee alternatives were not advertised to students
- Students required to pay \$100 for photography course materials and a no-fee alternative (digital camera, etc.) was not advertised or offered to students
- Students required to pay \$10 for a booklet of math worksheets or to print them themselves. A no-fee alternative was not offered to students
- Students told to pay \$60 for photography film and chemicals with no alternative offered or openly advertised
- Information on financial/fee payment assistance not published on school websites (Student Trustee R. Barnes and H. Jamal searched each school's website)

GUEST SPEAKERS

1. Chief Communications Officer (CCO), Nick Manning: Student Senator Brainstorming Session for Board Purpose Statement

Chief Communications Officer N. Manning, Student Trustee H. Jamal, and Student Trustee R. Barnes introduced the brainstorming activity at 7:15 p.m. Process:

- 1. Senators challenged to create 20 purpose statements in 5 minutes on sticky notes
- 2. Focus groups of 5-7 Senators were created to pick the best purpose statements from the group
- 3. Voting by means of a "dotmocracy" system allowed Senators to walk around the room and vote for their favourite purpose statement proposals
