Reporting to a designated Facility Supervisor(s), this position is responsible for the repair and preventative maintenance of all types of Hydronic and Steam heating systems as permitted by provincial legislation.

The successful candidate will work 40 hours per week 2:00 p.m. to Midnight. Rate of pay is in accordance with the CAMA/OSSTF agreement, Tradesperson category. (\$53,167 - \$58,804)

Responsibilities

- Work with minimal supervision
- Service gas and oil fired hot water heating systems
- Service and repair of various types of air handling systems
- Carry out boiler repairs such as refractory door rebuilding, piping repairs, short of any gas work
- Perform preventative maintenance and service on all hot water circulating pumps
- Perform preventive maintenance on roof-top units, heat pumps and fan coil units, short of any gas or refrigerant work
- Carry out service and repair of pneumatic control systems
- Perform steam trap repairs
- Other related duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Facility System Mechanic, Facility System Technician, Building Environment Systems Operator, Class 1 or Stationary Engineer, 4th class certification is required.
- Minimum grade 12 (OSSGD) is required or equivalent
- Knowledge of the operation of steam and hot water boilers



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- Knowledge and understanding of the Ontario Building Code, Ontario Fire Code, Occupational Health and Safety Act, WHMIS Regulations and Asbestos Containing Material regulations, transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) and safe handling of hazardous materials.
- Basic knowledge of Pneumatics and Direct Digital Control (DDC) systems
- Demonstrate a minimum of 5 years related experience in service at a comparable work site
- Knowledge of preventative maintenance schedules for all types of heating equipment
- Gas Technician 1 or 2 qualification would be an asset
- A certified course in basic electronics would be an asset
- Valid Class 'G' Driver's license with a clear and safe driving record is required. Board vehicle supplied upon signing of Vehicle use policy.
