# The Fast Forward Program is:

- A unique **diploma granting program** focussing on preparing students for the workplace
  - Designed to teach students the knowledge, employability skills and attitudes necessary to be successful in a work environment
  - Intended for students who are academically working below grade level
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# Consider the Fast Forward program for a student who:






- Has struggled with numeracy and literacy for a significant period of time
  - Is academically 2-4 years out of phase
  - Has had significant accommodations or modifications to their elementary school program
  - Has an Individual Education Plan (IEP).
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# Fast Forward Program Goals:






- Students earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)
  - Developing literacy and numeracy skills
  - Developing learning skills and employability skills
  - Preparing students for employment through work-related learning experiences
  - Greater student confidence as a learner and improved success in their academic program

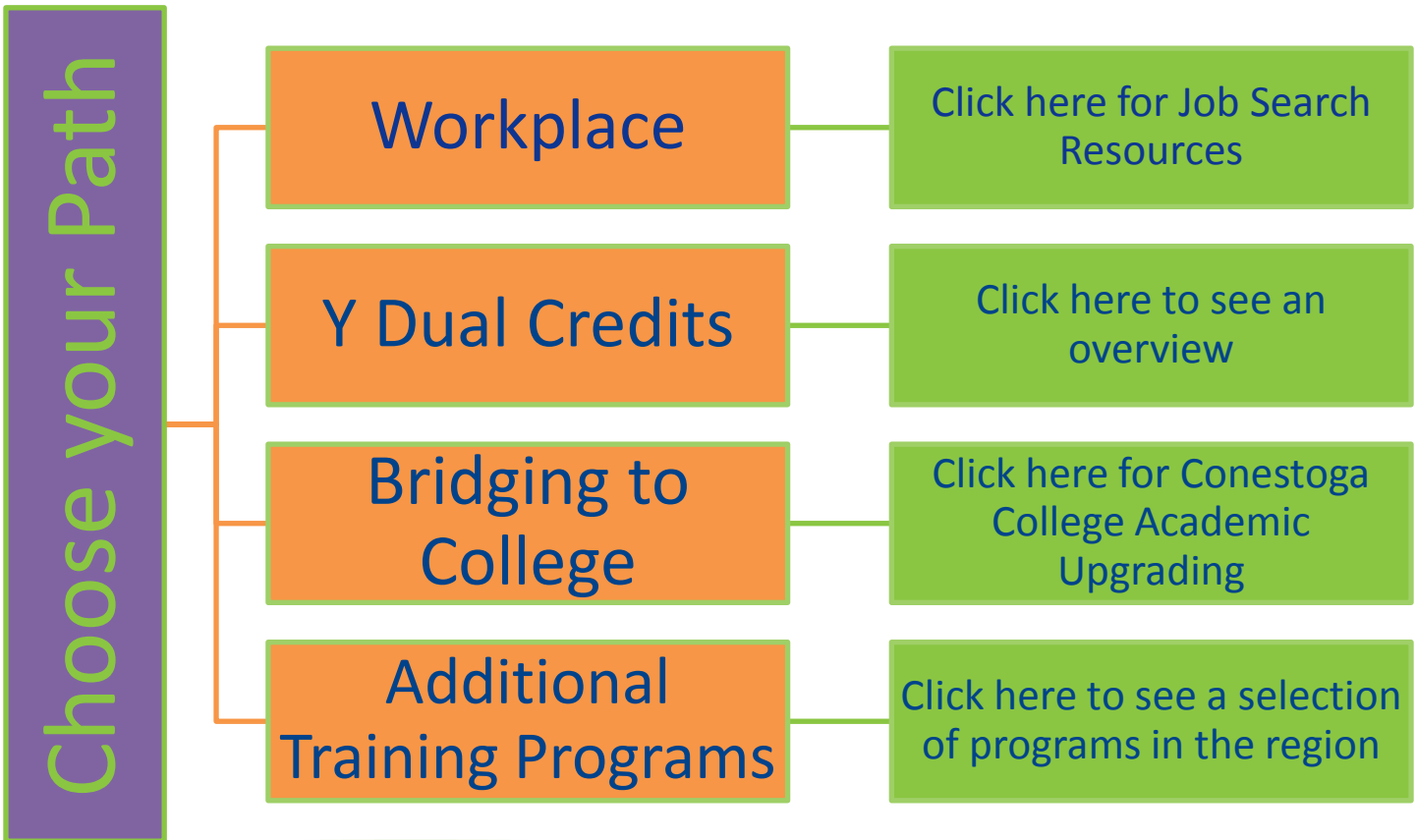
