Night School Online Co-op

The co-operative education program is designed for students who are not registered in a day school, who are 19 years and older, and need to fulfill their credit requirements for graduation. Students must obtain their own position or volunteer placement and have Internet access available to complete the required course materials.

What you need to register:

- Current Students (high school):**
 A copy of your credit counselling summary and a completed registration form signed by your guidance counsellor and your parent/guardian.
- Adults:** A transcript from your former high school, any other related certificates or translated international documents.
- A copy of your birth certificate, birth registration, passport, citizenship/permanent resident card or landing papers.
- A Counsellor will be available at registration for adult students needing support with educational planning.

There may be a \$50.00 **refundable** book deposit to be paid beginning the second night of classes. This is cash only and will be refunded to you on the last two nights of Night School. If you are unable to attend either of the last two nights, you will receive your refund at the beginning of the next semester. Please call for specific dates.
