What you need to register:

- **Current Students (high school):**
A copy of your credit counselling summary and a completed registration form signed by your guidance counsellor and your parent/guardian.
- **Adults:** A transcript from your former high school, any other related certificates or translated international documents.
- A copy of your birth certificate, birth registration, passport, citizenship/permanent resident card or landing papers.
- A counsellor will be available at registration for adult students needing support with educational planning.

There may be a \$50 **refundable** book deposit to be paid beginning the second night of classes. This is cash only and will be refunded to you on the last two nights of Night School. If you are unable to attend either of the last two nights, you will receive your refund at the beginning of the next semester. Please call for specific dates.

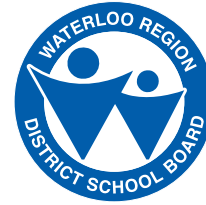

Night School Online Co-op Are you working? Do you still need to complete your high school diploma?



If the answer to both of these questions is yes, then night school online co-op is for you. The co-operative education program is designed for students who are not registered in a day school, who are 19 years and older, and need to fulfill their credit requirements for graduation. Students must obtain their own position or volunteer placement and have Internet access available to complete the required course materials.

Note: Courses may not run due to insufficient enrollment, so register early!

Weather closures: Do not call the school. Information will be provided to local radio stations, as well as on the WRDSB Main Website.

Transcripts to be sent to OCAS or OUAC require you to complete an Official Transcript Request Form. There is a fee involved for this service dependent upon the number of copies required.
