AMENDMENT TO APPROVED WEST GALT PUPIL ACCOMMODATION REVIEW MOTION

Manager of Planning D. Cuomo provided trustees with a report requesting an amendment to previous motions regarding the transportation of grandfathered students approved as part of the West Galt Pupil Accommodation Review in 2013.

When the proposed motion was approved in 2013, a small group of students were inadvertently excluded from the motion and it was identified that this group of students will be affected in the 2015-2016 school year.

Trustee J. Hendry objected to the wording under financial implications and felt it should say minimal cost instead of no cost.

8. Moved by C. Watson, seconded by C. Millar:

That the Waterloo Region District School Board extend transportation to grandfathered Partial French Immersion students, as set out in the text and on Appendix III of the report titled "Re-examination of the West Galt Elementary Schools Pupil Accommodation Review Administrative Recommendations," dated January 14, 2013, for a maximum of three years, ending July 1, 2018, subject to eligibility under *Board Policy 4009 – Student Transportation* and determined by the student's home address on June 27, 2013 and as presented at the March 23, 2015, Committee of the Whole Meeting.

CHICOPEE HILLS PUBLIC SCHOOL PLANNING APPROVALS UPDATE

Manager of Planning D. Cuomo provided trustees with a revised report and an update on the progress of planning approvals for the new Chicopee Hills Public School and the impact on the scheduled opening date for the school.

D. Cuomo commented on the lengthy and complicated process that staff has followed in order to meet the requirements to re-zone the lands necessary to build the new school. It was noted that approval by City Council has been granted and this now clears the way for construction to begin on the new school.

Under the revised schedule, construction of the pad for the school is to occur in early Spring 2016 with tendering in April and the start of school construction in May. Based on a typical build timeframe of 12-15 months, the school should be completed for cleaning and furnishing in July and August in time for the opening of the school in September 2017.

The revised schedule clearly demonstrates that an opening date of September 2016 is no longer possible. An opening date of September 2017 can be met given fulfillment of the remaining conditions of site plan approval and the construction timeline.

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Upon approval of the revised timelines by trustees, a school community meeting will be held to update parents and the public on the timing of construction and the opening of the school. Notification will be provided through the Board web-site and individual notices sent home to parents in the future Chicopee Hills PS attendance area.

That the Waterloo Region District School Board reschedule the opening date for the new Chicopee Hills Public School to September 2017; and

That the Waterloo Region District School Board revise the timing of the boundary changes and grandfathering provisions for Lackner Woods, Sheppard, Sunnyside and Stanley Park Public Schools, originally approved on May 9, 2011, as part of the Grand River South/Sunnyside Elementary Schools Pupil Accommodation Review, and subsequently amended on May 12, 2014, to coincide with the opening of Chicopee Hills Public School scheduled for September 2017.
