- Determine any facility issues or upgrades that would facilitate boundary changes, enhance program delivery, and address accessibility concerns.



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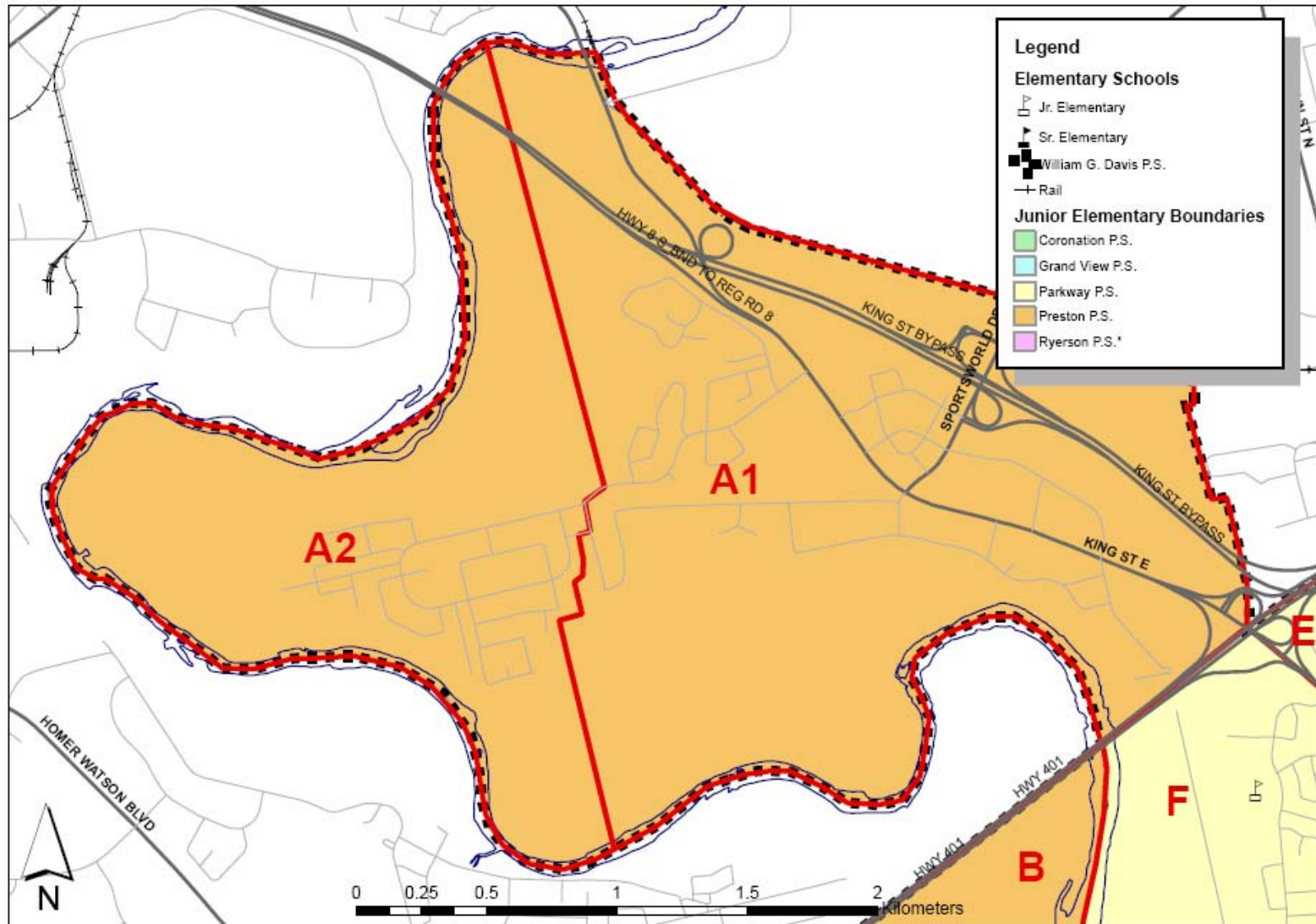

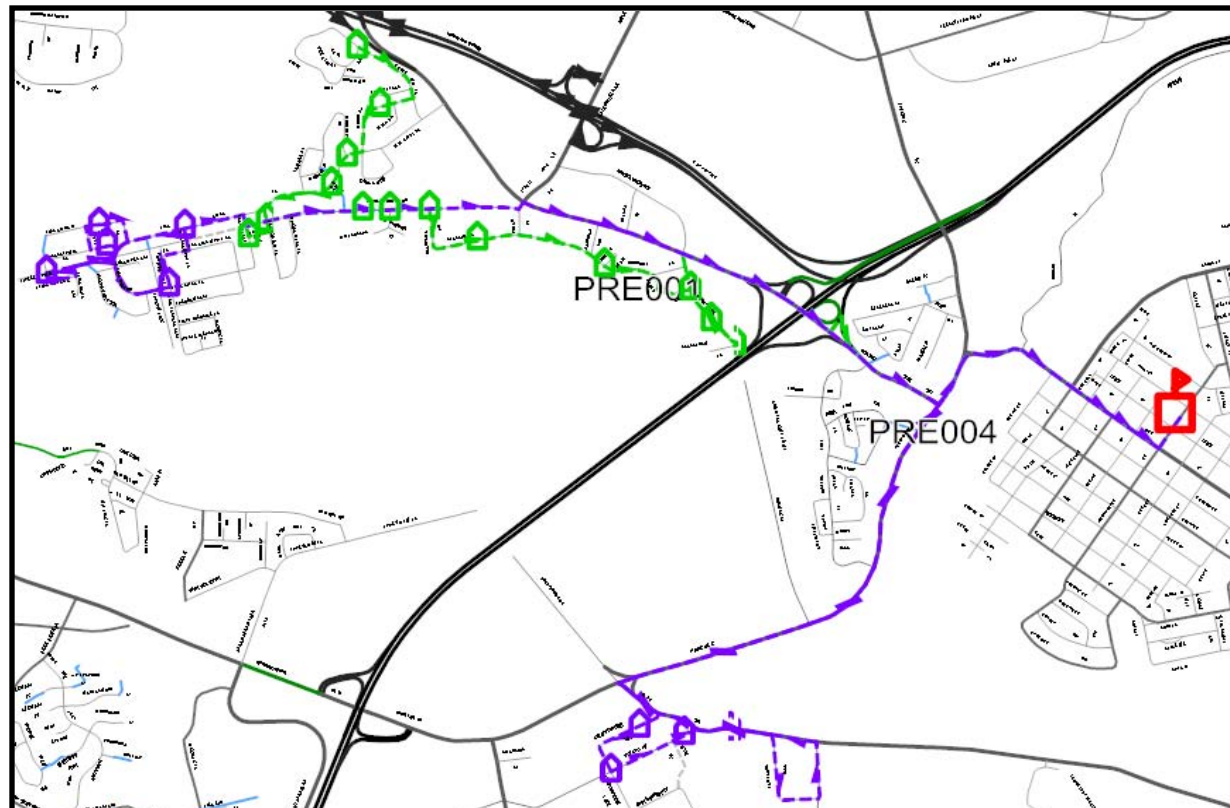


## Preston Boundary Study: Area A Division

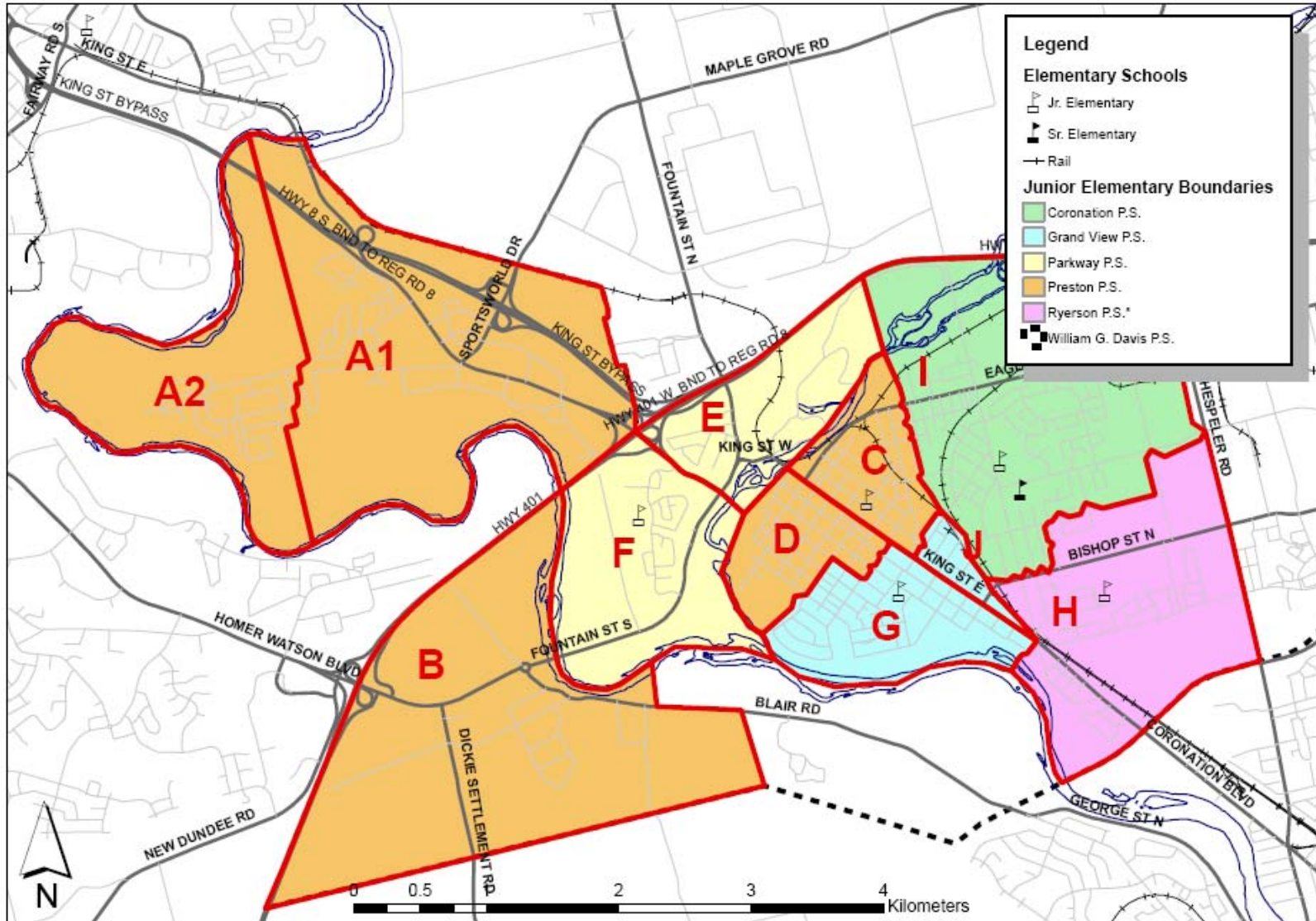

## Preston Boundary Study/Revised Enrolment Projection Areas

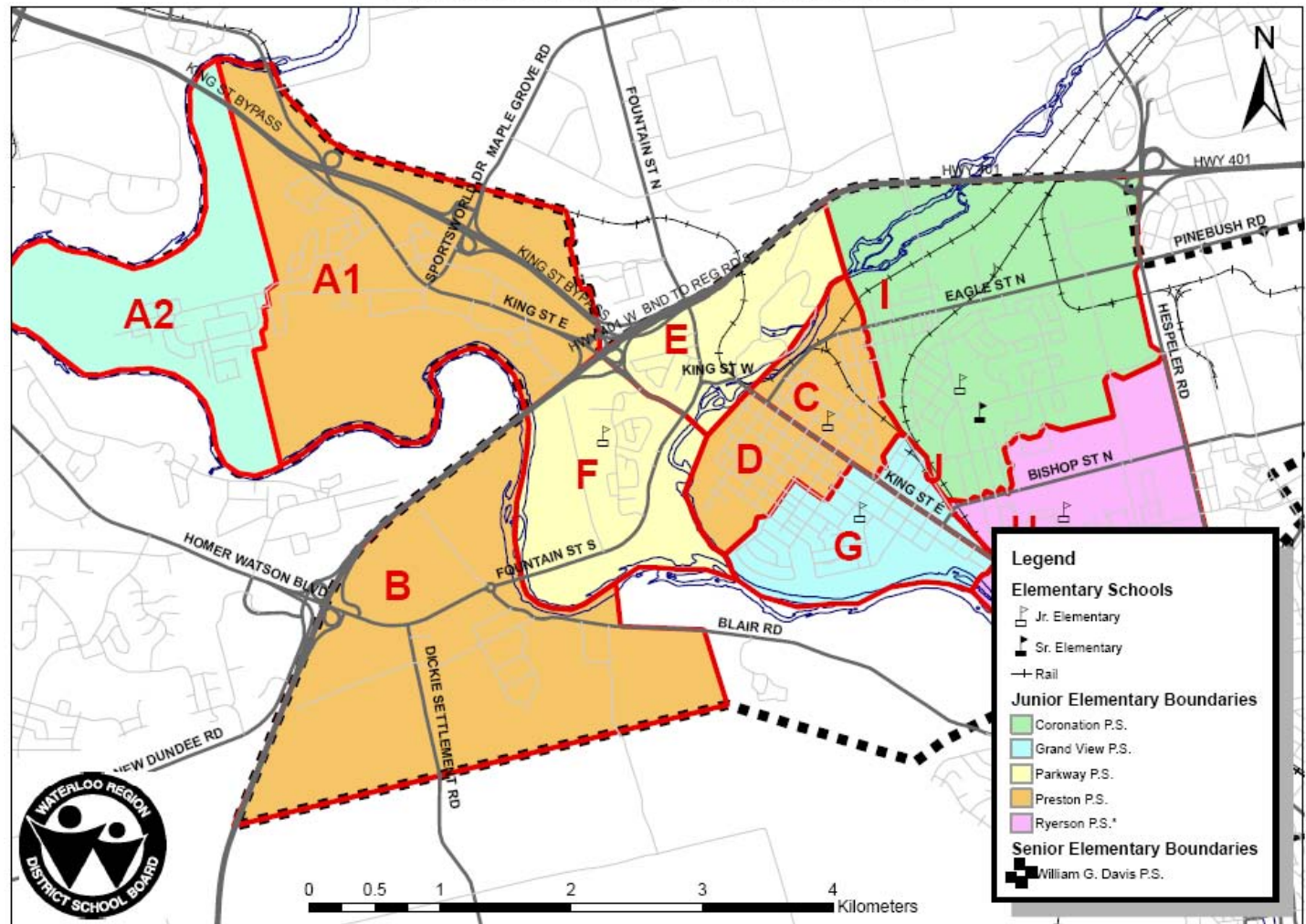

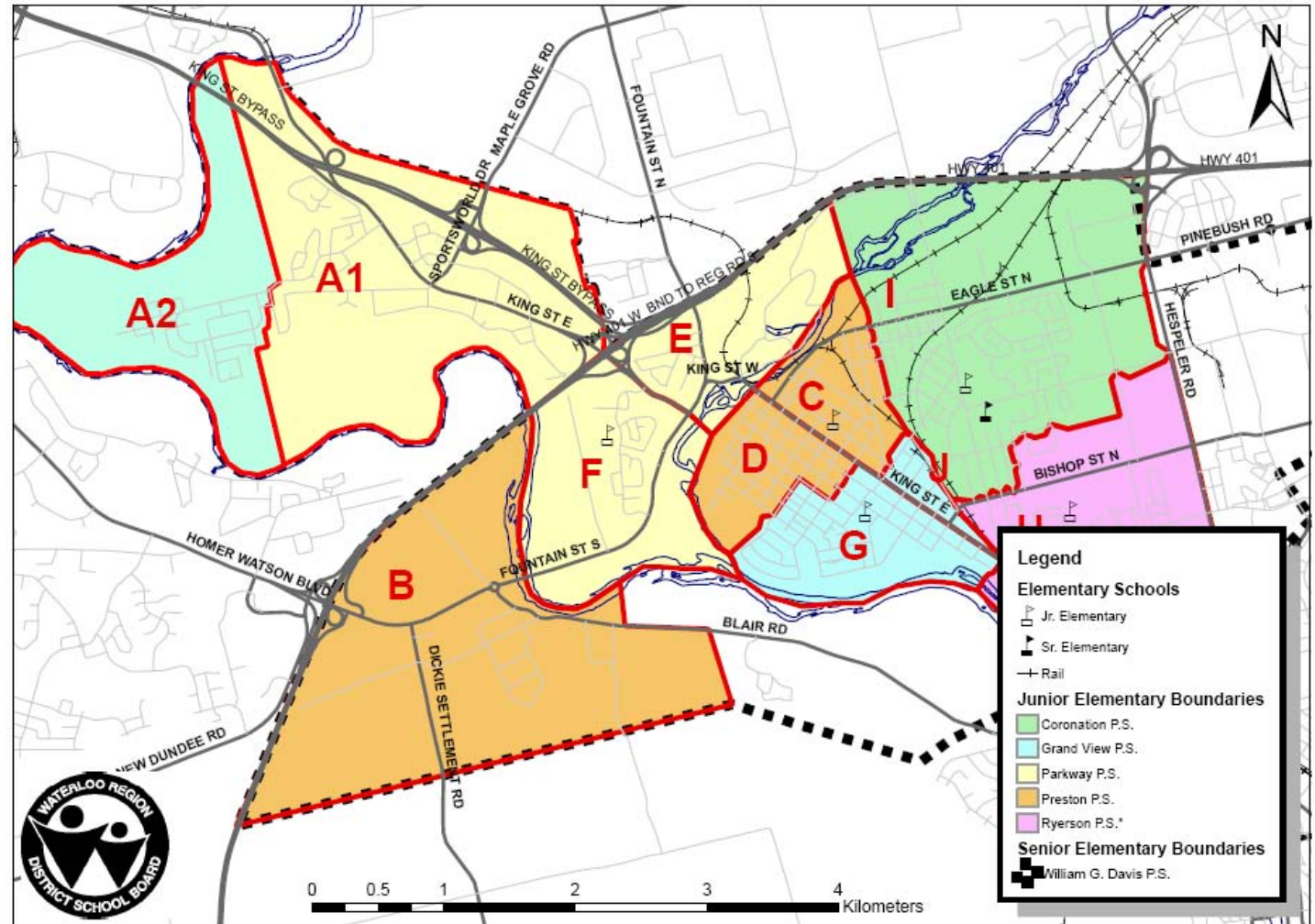

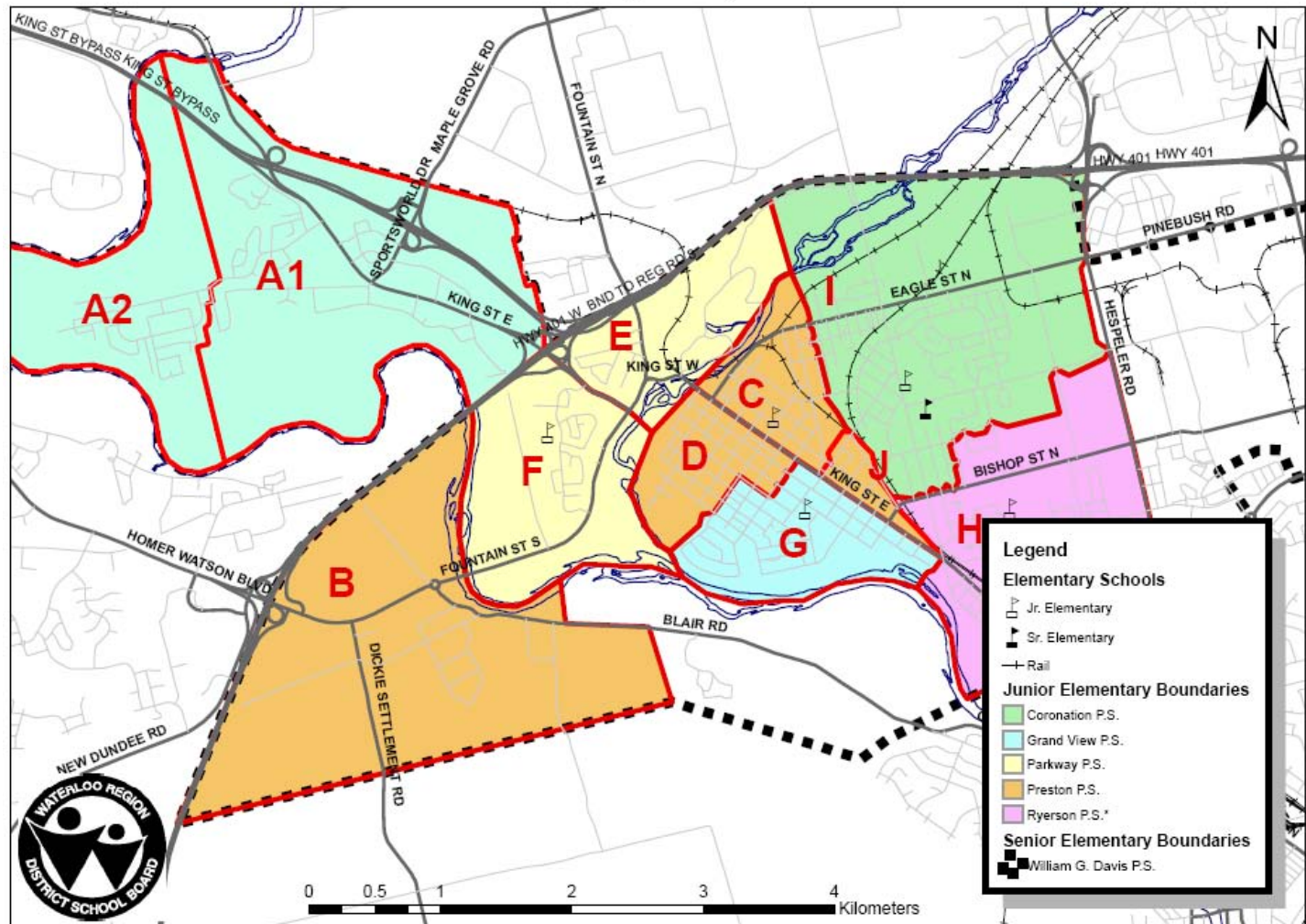

- Parkway P.S. decreases in short term, enrolment increases as development within boundary occurs
- Grand View P.S. increases enrolment, at capacity in short term, above capacity in midterm (approx two portables)
- Preston “Core” (areas C & D) community remains together
- Pioneer Tower community (area A) remains together
- Grand View “Core” (areas G & J) split
