




Timeline of Boundary Studies/Accommodation Reviews affecting schools in the Review Area









Board-Wide Enrolment Change 2003-2009


Full-Time Equivalent Enrolment Board-Wide 2003-2009

East KW Review Area Enrolment 2003-2009




2.5% increase in enrolment since 2003

Elizabeth Ziegler




- has acted as a "holding school" for new development areas, including Laurelwood, Eastbridge, Columbia Forest

King Edward




- Enrolment is relatively stable


8% decrease in enrolment since 2003



• reopened in 1993 as a temporary (15 year) structure




Lexington P.S. Timeline





Review Area Issues and Opportunities

Issues

- Lexington is a temporary structure
- Enrolment is declining across the review area
- Surplus space available at all schools
- Travel distance is too great to senior program
- Older, multi-storey, inaccessible buildings

Opportunities

- Board owns a site located at 410 Falconridge Drive, Kitchener
- If implemented, full-day kindergarten will increase utilization of existing facilities
- Review current elementary schools organization
- Partnerships with community groups
