



- Crestview receives an addition to become a JK-8 facility, receives Sr. F.I. program from Stanley Park P.S.
- Breslau P.S. receives an addition
- Area E moves from Breslau P.S. to Mackenzie King P.S. (JK-8)
- Area C moves from Mackenzie King P.S. to Smithson P.S. (JK-6)
- Stanley Park P.S. closes (Areas A, B, C, D, G attend Mackenzie King P.S.; Areas H, J, R attend Crestview P.S. for Gr. 7-8)
- Areas P and T move from Stanley Park P.S. to Sunnyside P.S. (7-8)
