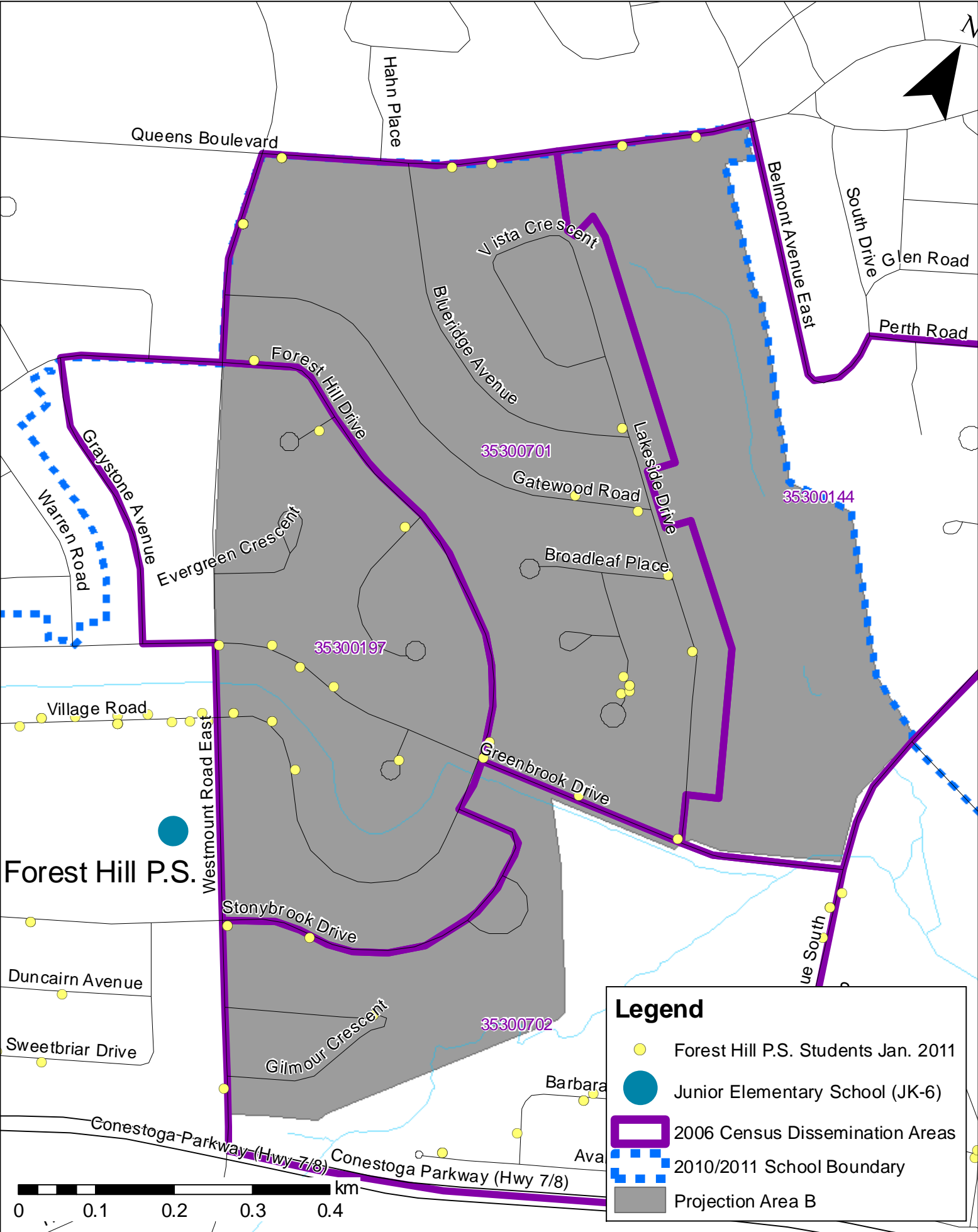

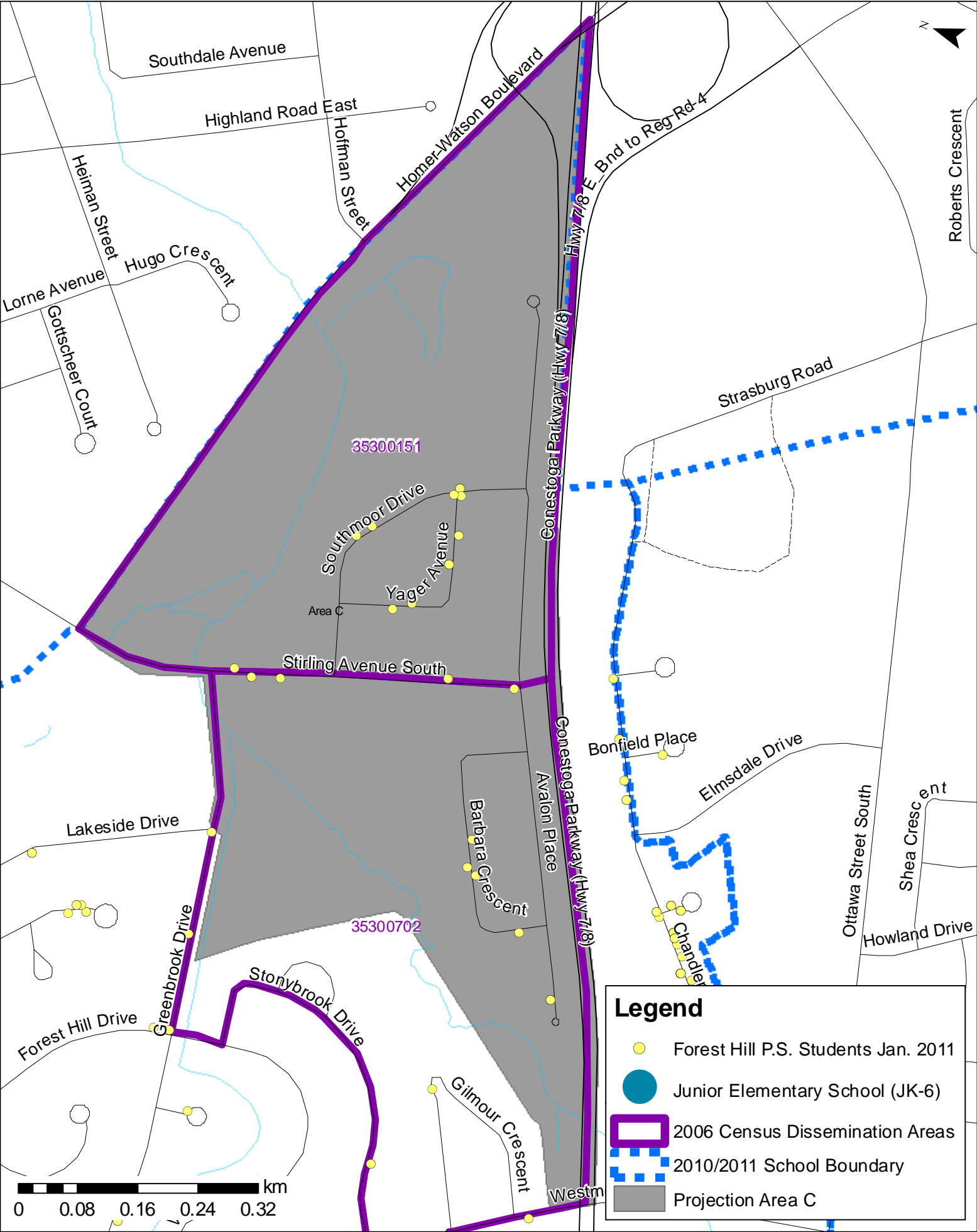

Forest Hill/Trillium Study Area - Projection Area C



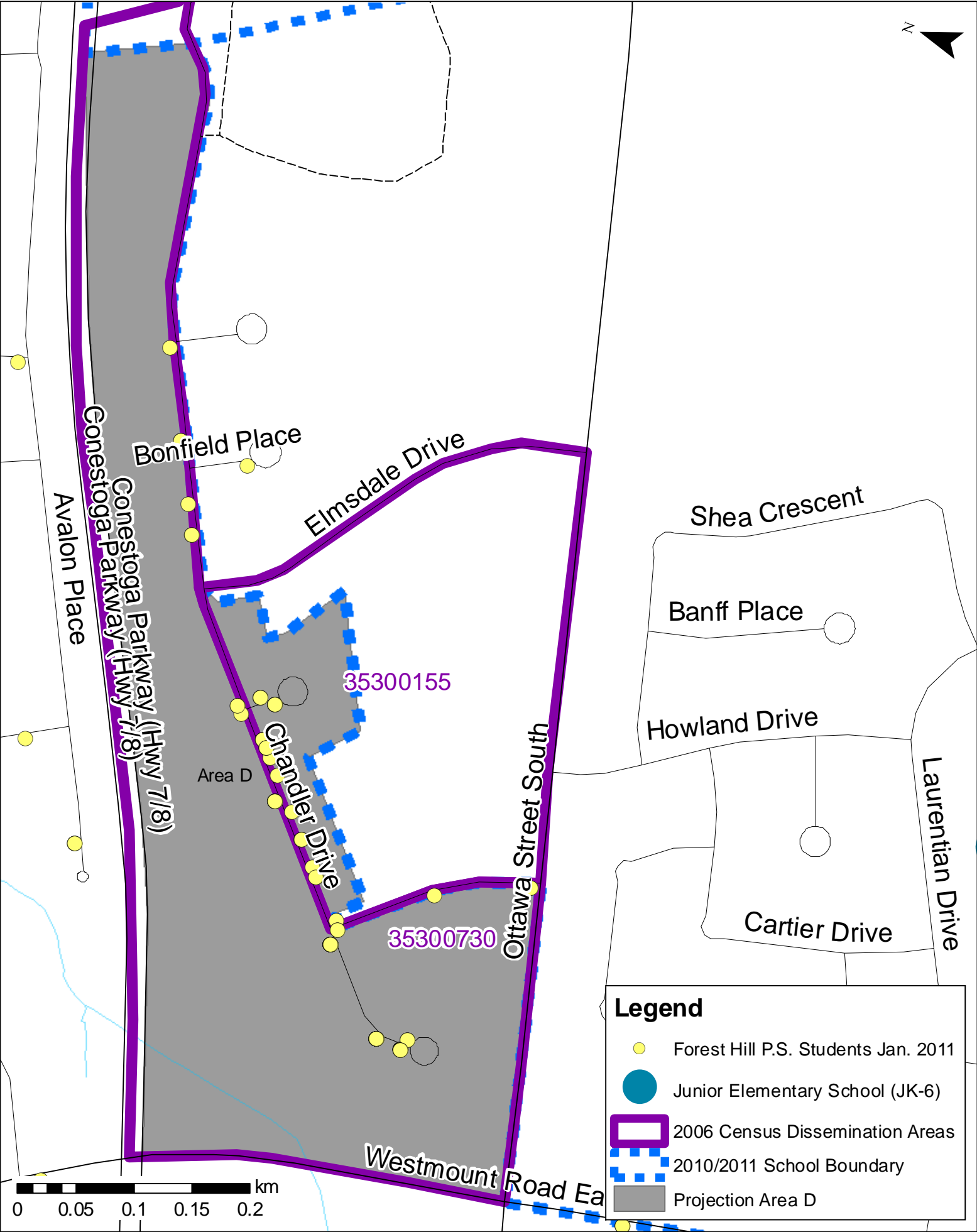

Forest Hill/Trillium Study Area - Projection Area G



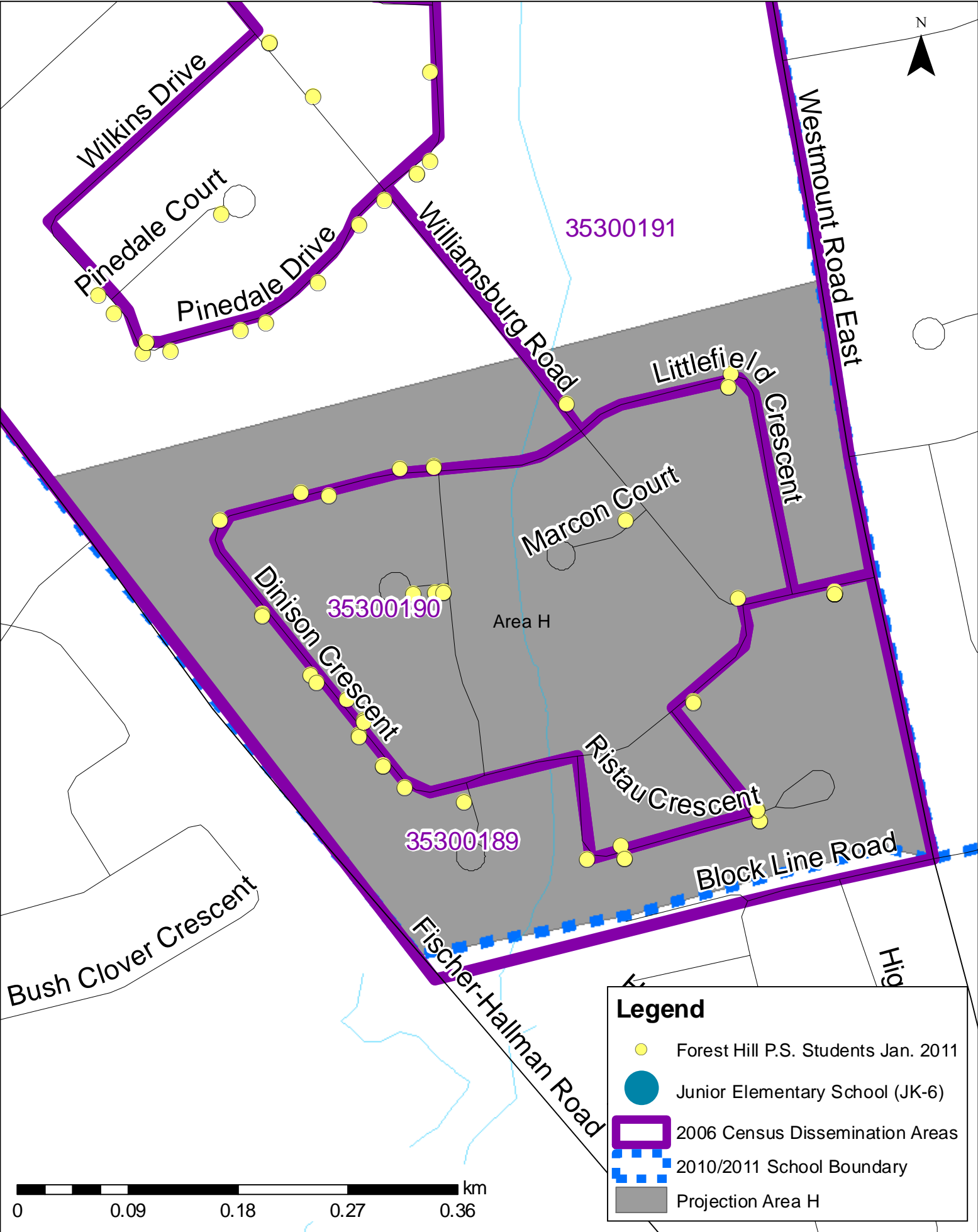

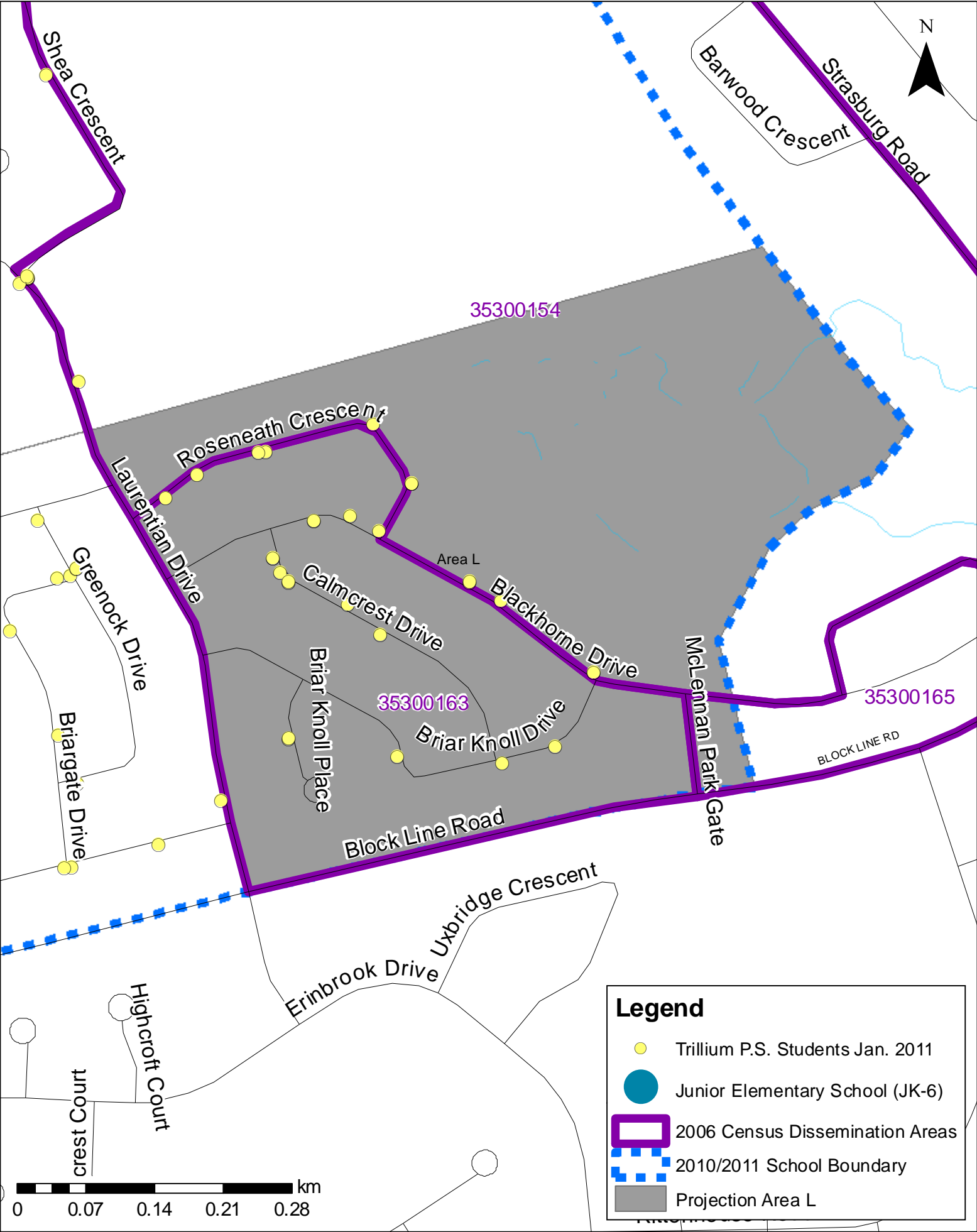


Forest Hill/Trillium Study Area - Projection Area K
