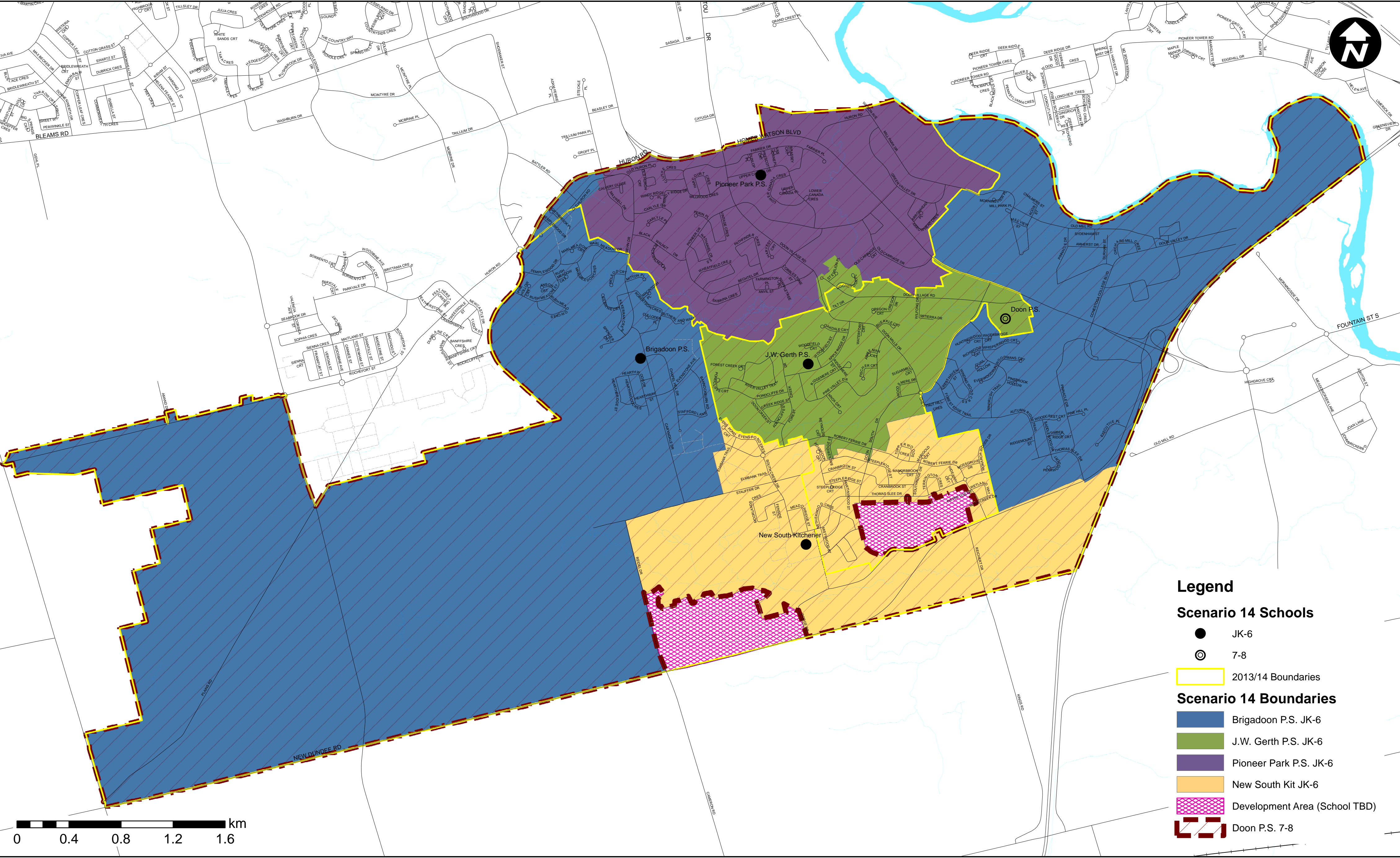


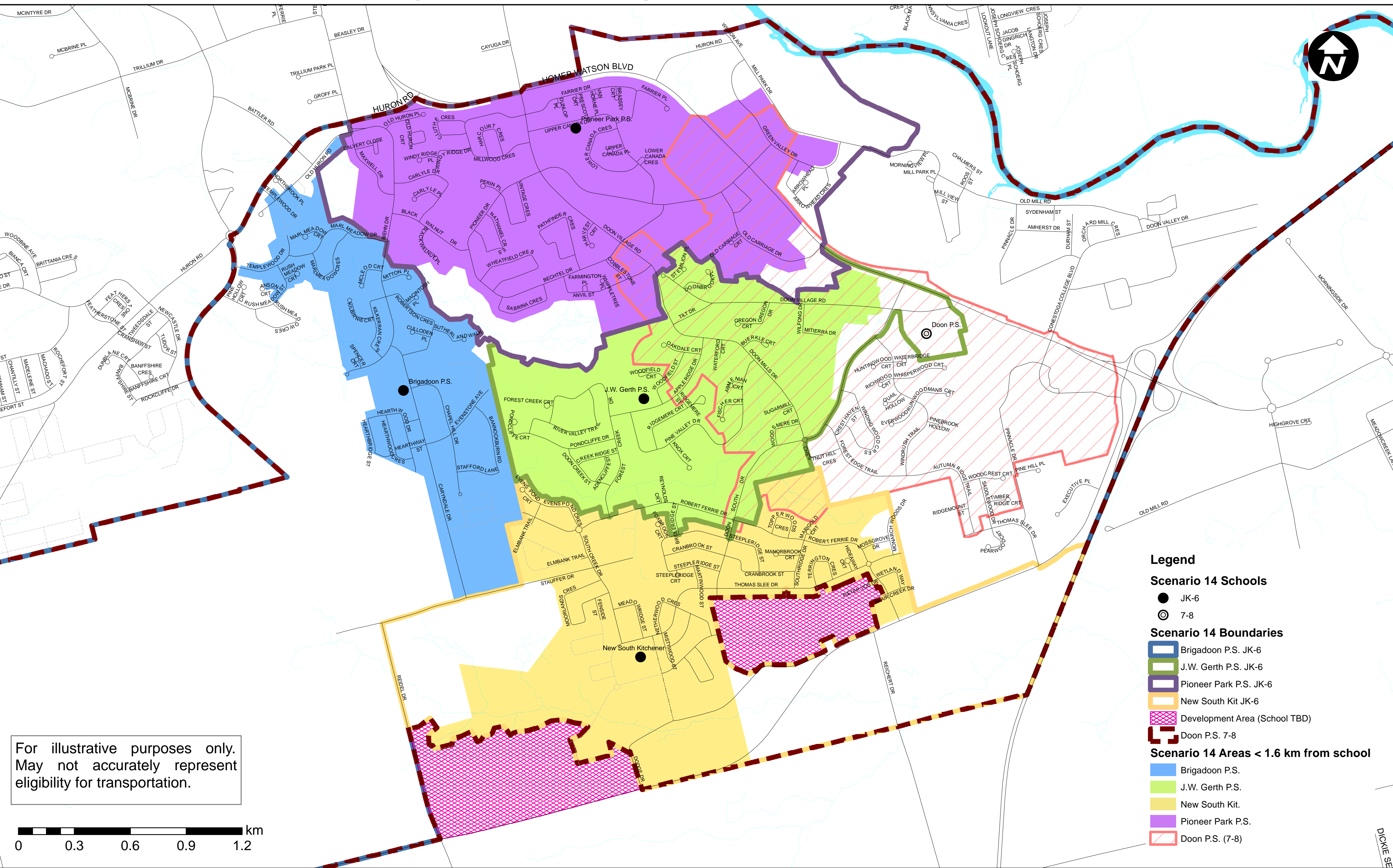

Scenario 14 F

2015/16 School Year

- New South Kitchener school opens JK-5
- All boundaries modified to implement changes
- All Grade 6 students in affected area moving from Pioneer Park P.S. to Brigadoon P.S. or J.W. Gerth P.S. grandfathered at Pioneer Park P.S.
- All Grade 6 students in the 2014/15 J.W. Gerth P.S. boundary attend Doon P.S. (J.W. Gerth P.S. and New South Kitchener school JK-5 only in 2015/16)
- All Grade 6 students in affected area moving from Brigadoon P.S. to New South Kitchener school grandfathered at Brigadoon P.S.
- Development Areas established - new students assigned to a school that has space to accommodate the projected enrolment until a permanent solution can be established.
- Offer French Immersion at New South Kitchener school (starting with Gr. 1-3 French Immersion in 2015/16 and working up to Gr. 6 by 2018/19)
- Grade 4-6 French Immersion out of area students and siblings grandfathered at 2014/15 school (Note: Student Transportation is governed by*Board Policy 4009* and *Administrative Procedure 4260*. If your child is not eligible for transportation under the terms outlined therein, transportation to and from school will be the sole responsibility of the parent/ guardian)

Approximate Capital Cost Requiring Approval: \$7M

NOTE: Enrolment projections are estimates based on several assumptions and use the most current data available. Development area projections are rough estimates of the number of students expected to be generated by proposed plans of subdivision. Only those units in plans with development applications currently under review by the City of Kitchener have been included in the projections. Timing of development is dependent on plan registration and the motivation of developers to proceed with construction (housing market).
