PURPOSE/STRATEGIC PLAN:

To update the Waterloo Region District School Board (Board) with respect to enrolment projections and school capacities for the schools involved in the Doon South Elementary Schools Boundary Study (Brigadoon, Doon, Groh, J.W. Gerth, and Pioneer Park Public Schools).

The three strategic priorities that are used to guide the work of the Board are:

• Our Students are First – Each and Every One

Our Staff, Families and Caregivers are Partners in Every Student's Learning Journey

• Our Culture of Innovation Builds Students' Confidence and Success as they Face the Future

BACKGROUND:

At the January 20, 2014 Committee of the Whole meeting, the Board of Trustees passed the following motion:

That the Waterloo Region District School Board approve Scenario 16 as outlined in Appendix A of this report titled "Recommendation Resulting from the Doon South Boundary Study", dated January 20, 2014, to be implemented when the new South Kitchener (Groh Drive) school opens

Specifically regarding French Immersion, Scenario 16 recommended:

That the new South Kitchener (Groh Drive) school offer French Immersion classes with the possibility of offering Grades 1-6 by the 2018/19 academic year, to be evaluated by staff to determine viability

In November 2016, staff completed their assessment regarding French Immersion (FI) at Groh Public School and determined that Groh Public School will offer a Grade 1 French Immersion class for the 2017/18 school year as long as a minimum of 20 children register for the program through the French Immersion Program registration process opening in January 2017. Groh Public School will not offer any French Immersion classes beyond Grade 1 for the 2017/18 school year. Staff notified parents and students affected in early January 2017 in order to inform their decision-making process.

At the January 16, 2017 Committee of the Whole meeting, Trustees requested additional information from staff regarding projected enrolments, site capacities and financial implications of opening of Groh Public School with French Immersion beyond Grade 1 for the 2017/18 school year.

STATUS:

Staff has compiled the requested information in Appendix A of this report.

As a result of the opening of Groh Public School, J.W. Gerth Public School's projected enrolment is 567 students for the 2017/18 school year. The projected enrolment will require 2 portables on site. Furthermore, as a result of the reduction in the number of students attending J.W. Gerth Public School, staff believes strain on the site will be reduced. The Board's School Travel Planner will continue to monitor the site and provide assistance as required.

COMMUNICATIONS:

All students impacted by the implementation of the Groh Public School Boundary described in Scenario 16 have been notified. Human Resource Services will start the Elementary school staffing process shortly with the goal of completing enrolment projections by March 31, 2017.

Further Information: Enrolment and Program Considerations as a Result of the New Groh Public School Boundary Implementation

In making the determination to not offer French Immersion at Groh Public School beyond grade 1 for the 2017/18 school year Board staff evaluated the number of students currently enrolled in French Immersion in what will be the new Groh Public School boundary for the 2017/18 school year. Additionally, staff evaluated two scenarios; one in which students in French Immersion who are within the new Groh Public School boundary remain at their respective 2016/17 schools (e.g. Brigadoon and J.W. Gerth Public Schools), and one in which a French Immersion program is implemented at Groh Public School up to Grade 4.

<u>Updated Enrolment Projections by Grade/Program</u>

Scenario 1 – French Immersion program at Brigadoon and J.W. Gerth Public Schools

* Please note these projections do not make any assumptions with respect to an incoming grade 1 French Immersion class, as the French Immersion registration process is currently underway. This methodology avoids double counting grade 1 students between the Regular Track program and the French Immersion program.

Staffing Implications

Provided **all** in boundary Grade 2 through 4 French Immersion students attend Groh Public School's program, there will not be a net increase in the number of French Immersion classes for the 2017/18 school year. However, the Board does not mandate French Immersion students to attend their in boundary school.

Figure 11 details the organization and number of classes by school for Scenario 1 for the 2017/18 school year. **Figure 12** details the organization and number of classes by school for Scenario 2 for the 2017/18 school year. In both scenarios the total number of French Immersion classes across all schools is 20.

Groh Public School French Immersion Program Considerations

While projections indicate there are no increased staffing costs* in implementing French Immersion up to grade 4 at Groh Public School for the 2017/18 school year, Board staff considered a number of other factors in determining that a French Immersion program at the school was not viable. Of particular concern were the French Immersion class sizes at Groh Public School. **Figure 13** details the class sizes and organizations of a French Immersion Program (up to Grade 4) at Groh Public School for the 2017/18 school year.

Board staff expressed concern about the viability of the program moving forward. Cohort attrition is a documented trend in the French Immersion program within the Board. With such small class sizes, any loss of students in the program through cohort attrition will create staffing challenges in the future at Groh Public School.

As well, the viability of the class sizes and organizations described in **Figure 13** is dependent on 100% of the identified French Immersion students currently at Brigadoon and J.W. Gerth Public Schools attending Groh Public School. While public sentiment suggests the community is supportive of implementing the program, it is not certain that all of the identified students would be in favor of leaving their current French Immersion schools.

The Board could require those students to attend Groh Public School in order to remain in the French Immersion program however there are concerns with the fact that the French Immersion program is a choice program and that this could create situations for families where siblings would be divided across two schools.

Existing French Immersion students within new Groh PS Boundary

With the implementation of the new Groh Public School boundaries there exist a number of French Immersion students who will be attending an out-of-boundary school should they remain at their current school (Scenario 1). **Figure 14** illustrates the distribution of these students by grade and school for the 2017/18 school year.

Doon South Elementary Schools Boundary Study – Portable projection 2017/18

The opening of Groh Public School will reduce the number of portables required at the Doon South area schools. Implementation of a French Immersion program at Groh Public School (Scenario 2) should further reduce the number of portables required to accommodate students within the Doon South area of Kitchener. Brigadoon and J.W. Gerth Public Schools should see a respective one and two classroom reduction in space (portable) needs. Groh Public School could accommodate these French Immersion classes within its On the Ground (OTG) capacity thereby reducing the overall portable need by three units (See **Fig. 15, 16**).
