



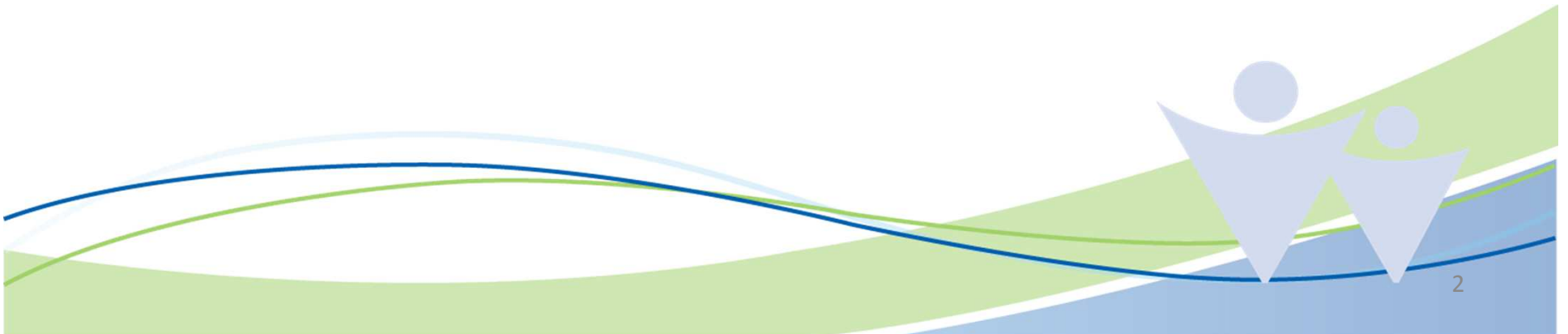

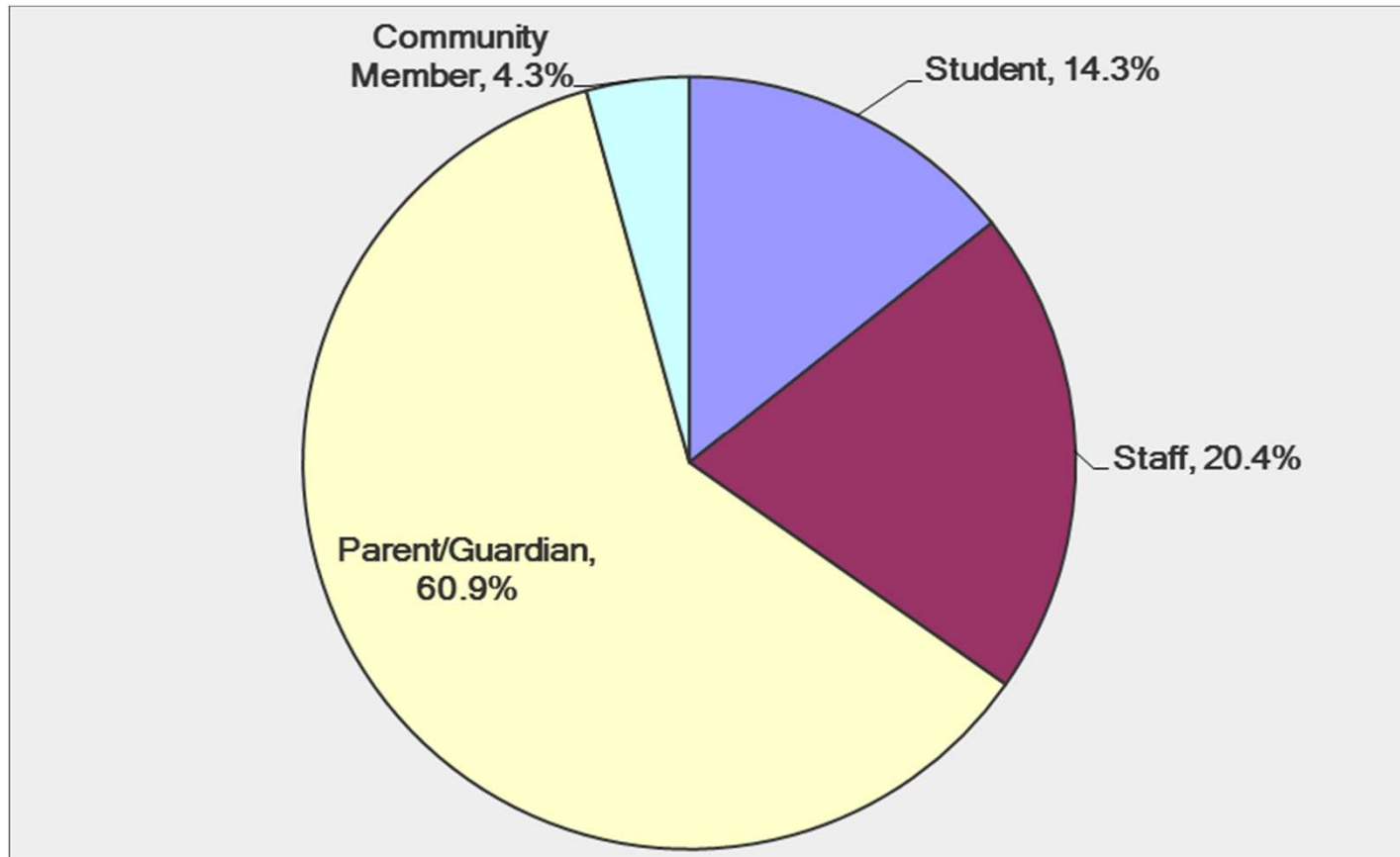

- 489 Respondents

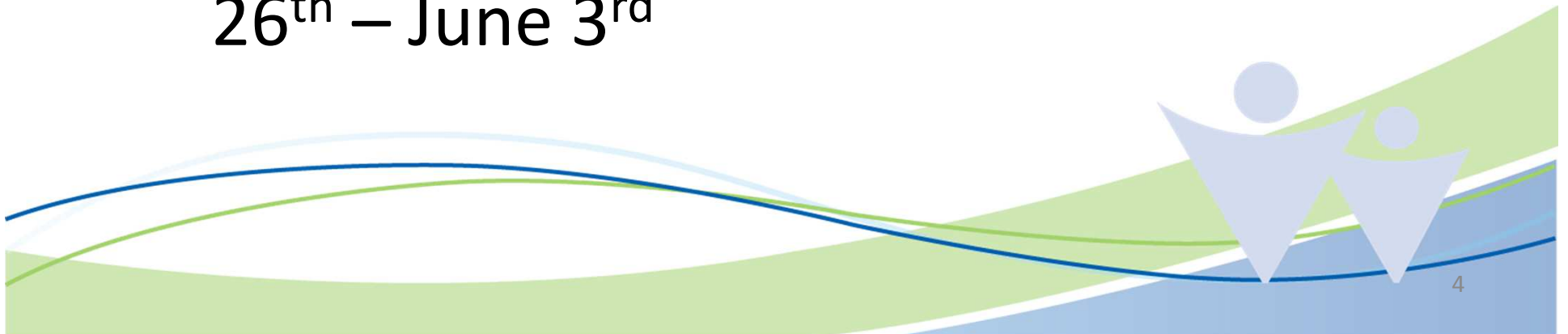

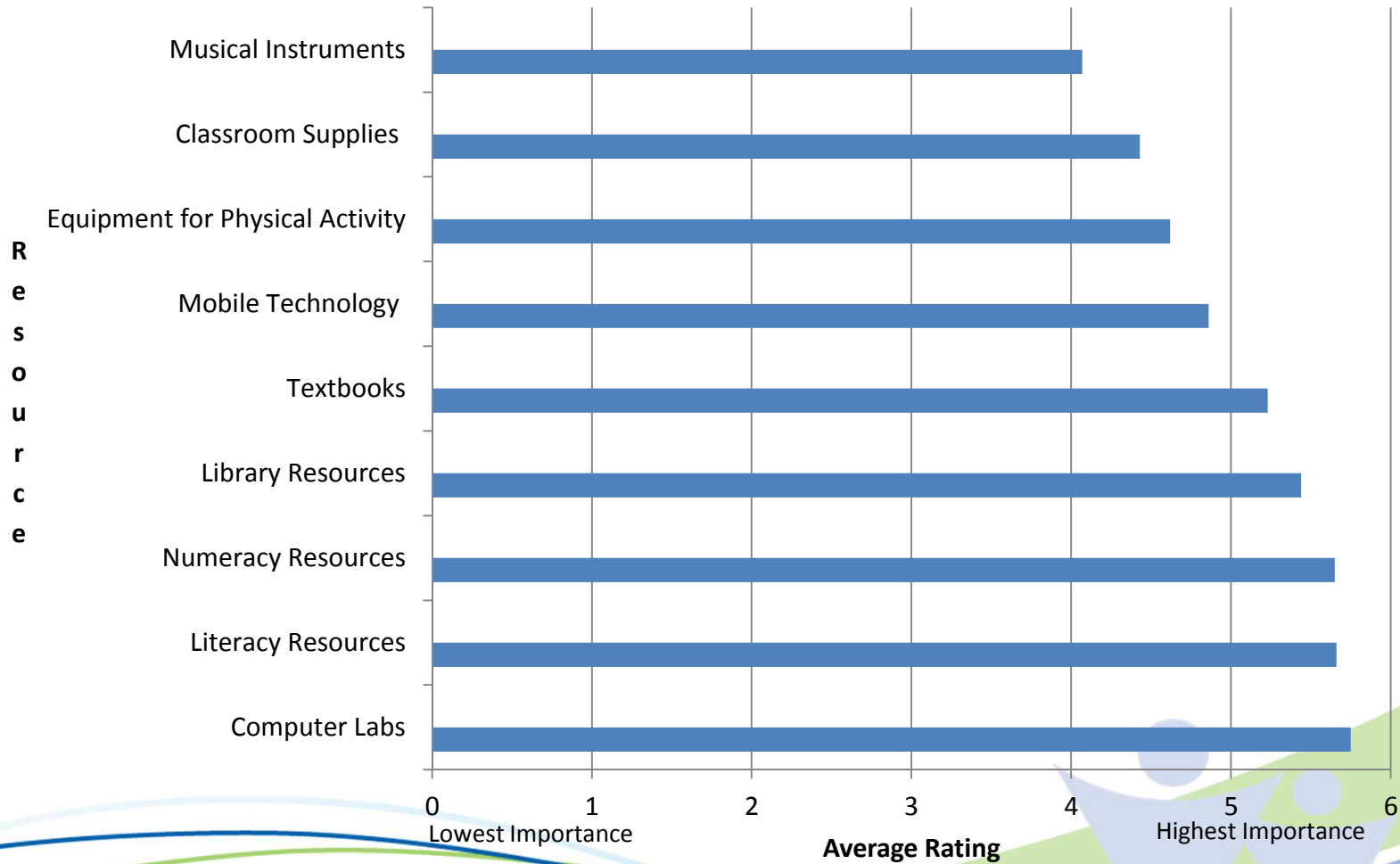
