WRDSB Administrators are trained in emergency response and WRDSB Schools complete a variety of drills throughout the to ensure student safety and preparation in the event emergency responses are necessary.
- Special Education Staffing 2018-2019: The contract extension money from this school year will continue for the 2018-2019 School Year. This staffing resulted in over 50 of our elementary schools receiving additional Special Education Resource Teacher staffing and all secondary schools received additional Special Education Teacher staffing as well. In addition to resource teachers there was also additional paraprofessional staffing (EA and CYW) that was allocated to both elementary and secondary schools.
