> What is it?

The Government of Canada has the Canada Learning Bond that provides money to youth towards their post-secondary education. It is for those who may need additional financial assistance.



This money could pay for your studies whether you are attending full time or part time at a college, university, a trade school, or apprenticeship.

> Am I Eligible?

To see if you are eligible for the Canada Learning Bond, check out the following:

- Live in Canada
- Born in 2004 or later
- From a moderate or fixed income family
- Have a Social Insurance Number (SIN) (We can help cover the costs of any identification needed to apply!)

> Ready to Apply?
