

PRIMARY CLASS SIZE FOR 2017-18 SCHOOL YEAR

In 2017, the Ministry of Education made a change to the [Education Act](#) requiring school boards to share information about class sizes in elementary schools with the public and with school council chairs.

The regulation reads:

Elementary School Classes — Reporting

Reporting

11.

(1) By October 31 in each school year, each board shall submit a report for the school year on class size in its elementary schools to the Minister, in a format acceptable to the Minister. O. Reg. 132/12, s. 11 (1).

(2) The board shall ensure that, by October 31 in each school year,

(a) copies of the report are available to the public at the head office of the board and at the office of each school of the board; and

(b) a copy of the report is submitted to the chair of the school council for each school of the board. O. Reg. 132/12, s. 11 (2).
