- Ministry of Education Proposal to Expand Access to Online Learning
 Presentation
 - A draft letter template will be provided that can be used by parents or organizations if they want to share their concerns with the Minister and local MPPs.
 - The hope is to put a pause on the current direction until a full review and consultation has been completed.

WRDSB Special Education Update - Scott Miller

- September 2021 Update (In-Person and Remote Learning)
 - Families were asked to complete a survey indicating their intentions for in-person or remote learning for the 2021-2022 by the beginning of May.
 - WRDSB Numbers are showing a decrease in students/families choosing remote learning.
 - Feedback from families is that they want their children to come back to in-person learning, but are still nervous with the current uncertainties.
 - Recent Ministry Of Education announcement has extended the timelines,
 so families now have until June 2nd to decide.
- Summer Update
 - Plans are being finalized for summer learning and mental health supports.
 - Summer Learning Programs and Summer School starts for three weeks beginning July 5th.
 - Special Education Resource Teachers will be hired to provide additional student supports.

- Technology will be supplied for families if needed.
- Grade 7-8 Summer School will focus on literacy and numeracy.
- Support from social workers, psychologists and speech and language pathologists will be provided.
- Continuing to meet with community organizations to work together to support students.
- Transition planning for back to school
 - Last 2 weeks of August.
 - Allow students a chance to visit schools.
 - A focus will be on supporting students with Special Education Needs that were in distance learning this year in an effort to help integrate students back to being in schools.
- School Year Calendar 2021-2022
 - Approved at board meeting on Monday, May 10th
 - Staff will return on September 1, Students will return on the September
 7th.
- Budget
 - We have received a preliminary budget for 2021-2022 which includes additional mental health funding.
- Retirement
 - Cindy Benedetti, System Administrator, will be retiring at the end of June
