- Ministry of Education Updates
  - A group was brought together requesting participation in the <u>Consultation: Initial Recommendation for the Development of Proposed</u> <u>Kindergarten to Grade 12 (K-12) Education Accessibility Standards</u>. A message was sent over the summer for feedback and asked to be provided for the September 2nd deadline. That date has been extended to September 30th (L. Gil to send the information again).
